

Rotary Club of Boise Young Professionals Membership Policy

Purpose:

To encourage the next generation of leaders to engage in service, networking, and professional development, Rotary offers a deeply discounted membership rate for young professionals.

Eligibility:

- Open to individuals aged 20–35.
- Must demonstrate an interest in community service, leadership development, and professional networking.

Discounted Membership Rate:

• Young professionals will only be charged **\$12** a month in membership dues for their first three years of membership. Regular membership dues are \$144.34 billed every other month. Lunch is provided every Thursday at no additional cost.

Benefits:

- Full access to all Rotary meetings, events, and service projects.
- Networking opportunities with experienced professionals and community leaders.
- Leadership training and mentorship programs.
- Eligibility for committee roles and leadership positions within the club.

Requirements:

- Join a committee or lead a service project.
- Attend weekly Thursday lunch meetings.
- Participate in and help plan two annual service projects outside regularly scheduled lunch events (Rake Up Boise, Wetland Peace Preserve, Bell ringing for Salvation Army, etc.).
- Participate in and help plan two social events during the year (better friendships dinner, Sip and Frolic, Paul Harris dinner etc.).

Application Process:

- Interested individuals must complete a membership application and attend an informational session.
- New members will be paired with a mentor to help them integrate into the club.

Review & Renewal:

- Membership fees will transition to standard rates after the discounted period, with flexible payment options available.
- The policy will be reviewed annually to ensure accessibility and effectiveness.
- Subject to early termination for non-participation.
